## The Australian Oracle User Group Prize

### PRIZE RULES

#### Establishment

This non-endowed prize has been established by the University as a result of a contribution by The Australian Oracle User Group (AUSOUG), its purpose to recognise and encourage outstanding Computer Science students.

#### Value

The value of the prize will be a voucher to the value of \$200.00 and a one year Australian Oracle User Group membership to the value of \$65.00 provided to the University annually by AUSOUG.

#### Eligibility

To be eligible for the prize students must be enrolled in any degree across the University and have completed the course COMP SCI 2207 Web and Database Computing in the year for which the prize is awarded.

#### Selection of Candidate

The Head of the School of Computer Science (or nominee) will award the prize to the student who places highest in order of academic merit in the course COMP SCI 2207 Web and Database Computing

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the Head of School will determine one winner.

#### Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
