

The ExxonMobil Award for Excellence in Petroleum Engineering

Establishment

This Prize has been established by a contribution to the University by ExxonMobil.
In support of the prize ExxonMobil shall provide an annual amount of \$1000.00 (GST free).

Value

The value of the prize will be \$1000.00 per year, until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the contributor.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students enrolled in the following degrees::

Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Petroleum)
Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Petroleum and Chemical)
Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Petroleum and Mechanical)
Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Petroleum and Mining)
Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Petroleum, Civil and Structural)

Selection of Candidate

The Australian School of Petroleum (or nominee) will award the prize to the 3rd year student who places highest in order of academic merit (based on the weighted average of the course marks) for studies undertaken in the first semester of their penultimate year.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
